

RECYLING



DISASSEMBLY

1. Place the table upside down on a soft, flat surface. Remove the cover components on each of the 4 corners.

2. Separate the tabletop from the frame by removing the screws located around the frame. Turn the screws counterclockwise to loosen them.

3. Next, detach the legs. To do this, remove the two screws facing diagonally outward on each corner. Afterward, remove the glider from each leg.

4. Separate all four corners from the frame elements by removing the screws connecting the parts.
