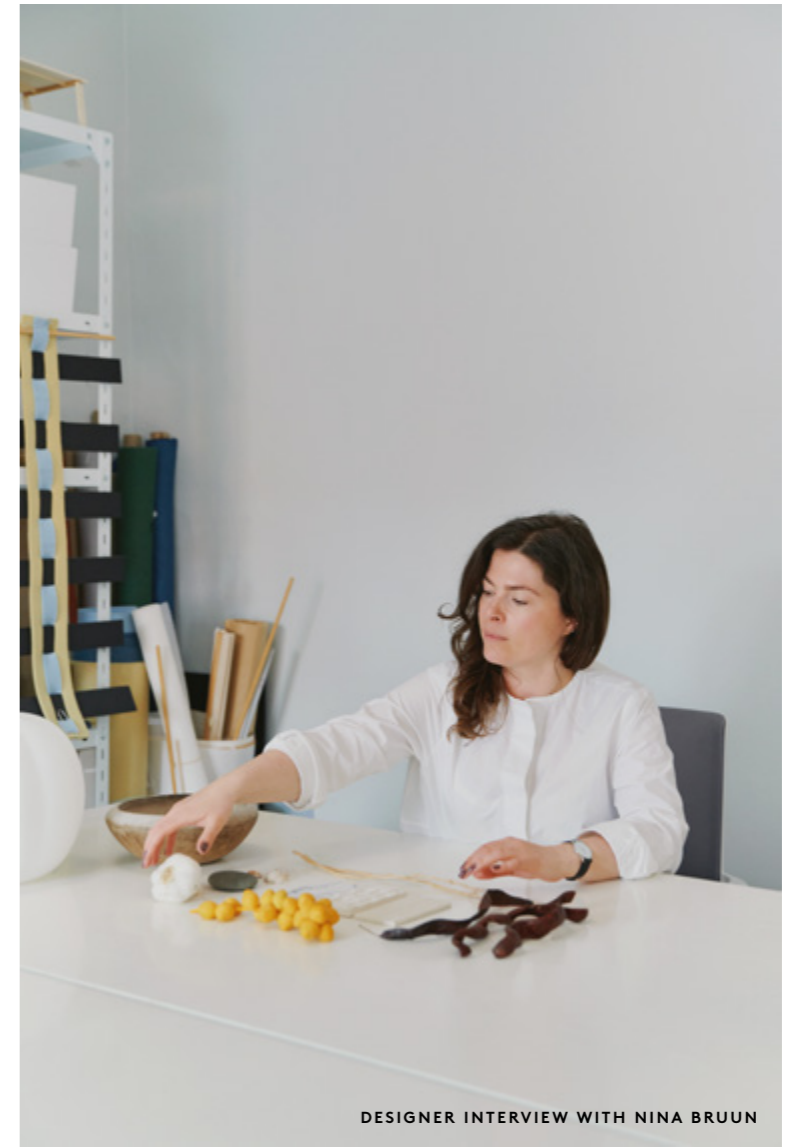

Fundamentals of our brand



The process of creating our designs with designers and makers requires artistry and a deep knowledge of each craft and its technical boundaries. The fundamentals of Made by Hand are how designs merge with artisanship via a creative process, and how materials must be carefully chosen and crafted into beautiful, timeless and functional designs.

Made by Hand works with a range of different workshops in Denmark and abroad, and the makers are all critical to the quality and details of our designs. This is a collaborative process and the work with design ideas, testing prototypes, shapes and function is an innovative journey where traditional methods are important. We respect and nurture the time and care taken with every process.



METAL WORK

The idyllic countryside of Denmark is home to many of our metal workers and workshops where experienced and talented makers create our designs in honest materials. Both traditional tools, as well as modern machines are behind our classic workshop lamp made in aluminum and the Petite Machine lamp with pressed parts, brass sections and lots of details.



KNITTING WORK

Knitting is an old craft, but not used for modern design lamps before Made by Hand started to explore how it was possible to create a knitted lamp with aesthetic beauty and functional light, back in 2016. In the beautiful countryside in Austria, we found a very experienced old company, Kobleder, a third-generation family with many years of skilled knowledge of knitting production.

The Knit-Wit lamp is a 3D knitted shade made of flame retardant yarns creating a very poetic distribution of light. After several years of testing

ideas, design shapes and knitted prototypes, the Knit-Wit lamp emerged with the help of the engineers and technical skilled people at Kobleder, helping us and the designers to solve the knitting part. Today each Knit-Wit lamp is knitted without any waste in the production.

The new Flying lamp from 2023 is also 3D knitted in Austria by Kobleder and has the same sustainable foundation as Knit-wit lamp even though the design is very different.

DYING AND WEAVING WORK

The NABLA collection of rugs is made in collaboration with Golran in Milan. Through technical excellence provided by Golran and their workshops in India, NABLA rugs highlight meticulous attention to detail and tactility with a contemporary touch. The collection is composed of four tonal gradations, woven together with the softest bamboo silk and the finest New Zealand wool. The colour-dyeing process is long and requires a deep knowledge of the interplay of materials and colour. The resulting creation is a beautiful gradient design where the softness of the bamboo silk contrasts with the wool's durability.

GLASS WORK

As a material, glass is incomparably intriguing; smooth, shapable, scaleable and beautiful in its variety of transparencies and textures. Glass making is an

ancient craft and glass reveals its beauty through light, which highlights the shapes in the design. The PePo lamp is an unusual mouth-blown glass lamp with its inspirational shape inspired by the pumpkin; a very organic and appealing design. The PePo lamp has a traditional function, but the form embraces soft waves and movements that are not usually referenced in glass lamps. With its playful glass nod to the pumpkin silhouette, its repetitive pattern gives the PePo lamp a versatile appeal from all angles, while the "stem" adds a fun and iconic element.

RICE PAPER WORK

Rice paper has many unique qualities - lightness, elegance and tactility, which make rice paper lamps appear as almost like floating sculptures. The Papier lamps are handmade - the structures are created from meter-long lanes that create the shape, then pieces of paper are attached, one at a time. The support frame for the Paper lamp is pre-bent according to each design, and is then welded and painted.

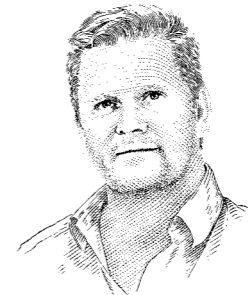
It is a fascinating and almost hypnotic process to watch the lamps come to life. The properties of rice paper are amazing, the way in which the paper can distribute the light and create mood simply by means of structure and translucency is difficult to imitate. The distribution of the light through the paper is not only very aesthetic but also highly functional and practical.



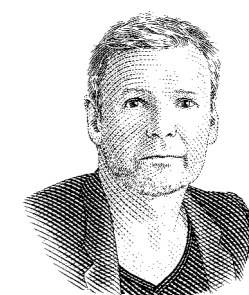

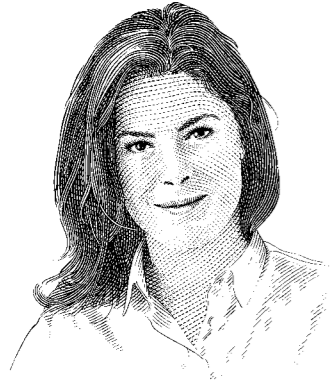
Ro Lamp

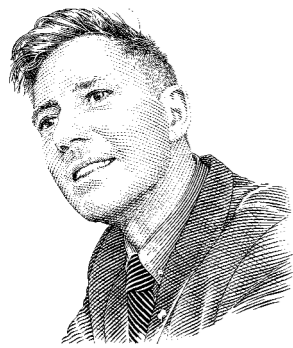

Knit-Wit

ISKOS-BERLIN is a Copenhagen based studio, founded in 2010 by design duo Boris Berlin & Aleksej Iskos. Their activities cover a broad spectrum of design fields from product and furniture design to graphic, exhibition and interior design. Their cooperation began at KOM-PLOT Design, where Boris Berlin was a co-founder and partner, and Aleksej was employed as an assistant for more than 11 years.

The products designed first within KOM-PLOT and then in ISKOS-BERLIN have won numerous national and international Design Awards and are represented in collections of several design museums around the world. Among them are the Design Museum Denmark; Die Neue Sammlung - The International Design Museum Munich; Vitra Design Museum, Weil am Rhein; Museum of Modern Art, New York and more.

With inspiration drawn from classic pin-stripe suits and American color field paintings from the 60's, Studio 0405 has designed Made by Hand's collection of throws with an intentionally classic pattern. The lines of the throw make a small landscape when draped over a couch or chair. Letting the lines meet in the middle of the throw activates the entire surface and turns it into a rich, luminous object rather than just a piece of fabric. Each throw is made of 60% Merino wool and 40% lambswool and is made in Sweden with tactile details such as handstitching and hand-sewed logo.

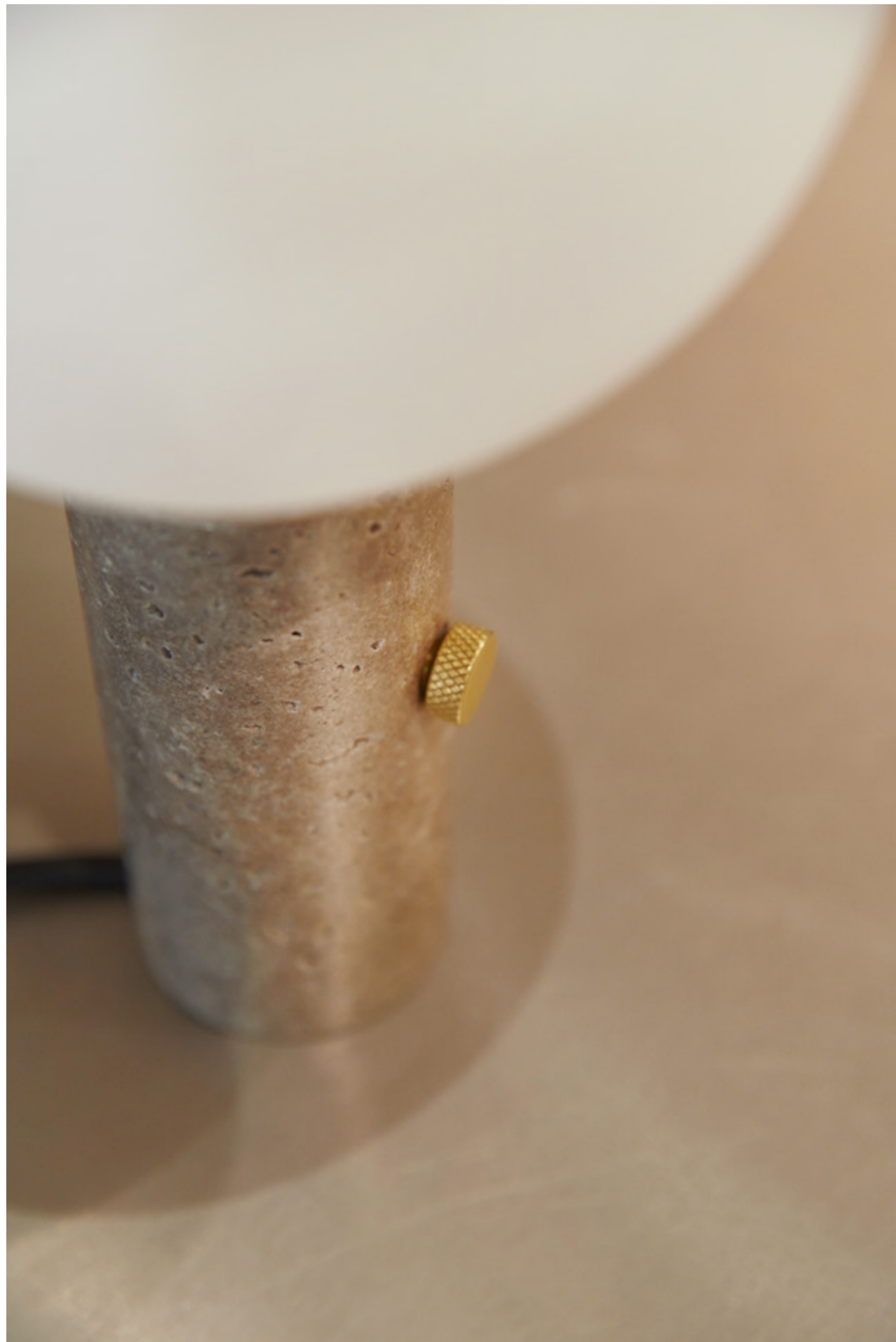

Tell us about your background in design and the establishment of your own studio?

I graduated as an Engineer of Architecture 24 years ago, gaining experience in a variety of architecture and interior design roles. During that time, I worked for global hospitality brands like Marriott Holding and Accor but after such an extended period of honing my skills, I realised it was time to pursue my own dream. I had a vision of how I wanted to run my own atelier, to be creative in my own personal way and create unique spaces in which to live and dine.

Why did you choose to have your studio in Dubai?

Initially we started the studio in Hong Kong and Malaysia, but while I was in Dubai to register our office there, the world suddenly ground to a halt. Once Covid struck, we found ourselves marooned in lockdown for more than 16

weeks. The natural response was to focus on the local market, and so quite organically Dubai became the central point of our operations and we decided to commit ourselves to growing in what has become one of the world's most vibrant and visionary cities.

How is it to work in the Middle East and are the projects different in requirements, size etc. compared to Europe?

Working in Dubai is actually quite similar to other territories for the most part. I've experience working in so many different countries and environments, so I have a clear understanding of how things vary from region to region. The most distinctive thing here in Dubai is the timeframe in which you have to deliver a project. Timeframes are generally much faster here than in Europe or in Asia. People are very brave and ambitious, wanting to achieve

something new and ground-breaking, and we are grateful to name some of the UAE's creative visionaries as our clients.

What kind of projects are you most fond of?

I love hospitality projects as the creativity and brave mindset of the owners is infectious. It's very rewarding to see a concept working and to experience how much the guest are enjoying the space.

Is it a conscious choice as to the kind of projects or clients you work with?

During our two years in Dubai, we have been very grateful for an amazing mix of projects and clients. 95% of our clients are local Emiratis and it is very inspiring to witness the enthusiasm of the new generations of entrepreneurs that are living the vision of the founders of the UAE.





How would you describe your personal interior design style?

Modern, sleek, elegant with references to art and a big focus on materials, haptics and lighting.

Where do you find inspiration for your work?

My biggest sources of inspiration are art, traveling, old movies and nature. So many of my projects are inspired by light and colour in nature, from earth and stone colour palettes through to reflective and textured materials, I love to echo nature's beauty in the spaces I design.

Which places give you creative energy both at home and during travel abroad?

I love watching the sky while I'm flying on a plane. The ombre effect of the sky is unique and I've wished so long to be able to one day create a place that gives you

this same feeling of peace and freedom that you have looking at the sky or watching the sea.

What do you do when not working – the work-life balance?

This is the biggest luxury for me right now – time. It's a rare thing these days since we've become so busy but I do try to practice Muay Thai, and I meditate every day, and sketch or paint when I can. When I have a little more time I love to cook and invite friends over.

What are you most passionate about?

Design in general, but my biggest passion is designing with light and glass, I love the material and the variety of ways that light breaks into it. I love reflective surfaces and creating new effects.

What is your ambition for XO Atelier and the studio opening in Feb, 2022?

My goal is to continue to grow from strong foundations, produce more incredible design concepts and gain more awareness for myself and my team beyond the borders of the GCC. Creating with love for lovely people while designing beautiful things.

Can you share a quote or a motto that guides your way of living or thinking?

Be passionate in what you do or don't do it at all.

What projects from the past mean the most do you?

Toplum Cafe as it was the first under XO Atelier but also because it won the category of Best Restaurant for the International Hotel & Property Awards.



What are your perspectives as a designer living in the global design community?

Creating designs and interiors is all about creating a feeling. Creating a space that captures the emotions of the visitors is the goal, like an artwork or a beautiful scent. It is not so much about the storytelling inside a design, it is about the resonance between the design and our subconscious. I think we need to learn to create with more empathy and less imagery.

The Ritual project is another project from your studio. What was the vision for this, and what challenges did you face and need to solve in order to fulfil both your client and your own expectations?

The client brief on the Ritual Cafe & yoga studio was different than the usual briefing. The space is created as a city escape offering the client a cafe and restaurant in combination with a yoga studio. The concept was created to reflect the holistic

approach of the Emirati client Ms Sherina AlSowaidi who wanted to create a retreat and refuge in the city of Abu Dhabi. For us it, was important to reflect the essence of yoga in the design. Simplicity, airiness and calm surroundings to highlight the minimalistic design and the calm design style of the space while following our own design language. The space connects two levels and we created a new stairway leading the guests towards the yoga studio. The shapes are clean and minimal and follow the sleek geometry of the space. The colours of the space are inspired by the light sand tones of the region highlighted with some colour accents in saffron and cream tones while using different textures. To support the functionality and create a connection with the double height space, we decided to use the Knit-Wit lights by Made by Hand and arranged them in a cluster installed in the double height void. It was important for us to select the Knit-Wit lights as the design of

the light is reflecting the overall design mood of the space while adding a calming and warm design element to the space. The half transparent surface of the lights and the soft shapes add to the geometric space.

Interviews

Nina Bruun

Please tell us about your studio?

Nina Bruun Design Studio is a multidisciplinary creative studio based in Copenhagen focusing on product- and furniture design, color and trendwork. I established the studio in 2016 after years in the industry. I've always been drawn to the beauty in things and I love to translate the impressions I meet on my way into design.

focused on designing a functional lamp that changes as you move around it - making it interesting and ever-relevant, alone, in pairs or in clusters.

What are the challenges of working with glass in terms of production?

Working with glass is challenging, especially when aiming for perfection and really good quality. It takes time to find the right specialists to work with, and after that finding the right methods, quality and expression. Something that you don't think about is the fact that glass shades looks very different depending on whether they are lit or not - and it's very important for us that the lamps look great both ways so, we had a lot of focus on that.

What are the key design attributes of PePo lamp?

The PePo lamp has a traditional function, but the form embraces soft waves and movements that are not usually referenced in glass lamps. The pumpkin-inspired shape and repetitive pattern gives it appeal from all angles, while the "stem" adds a fun touch.

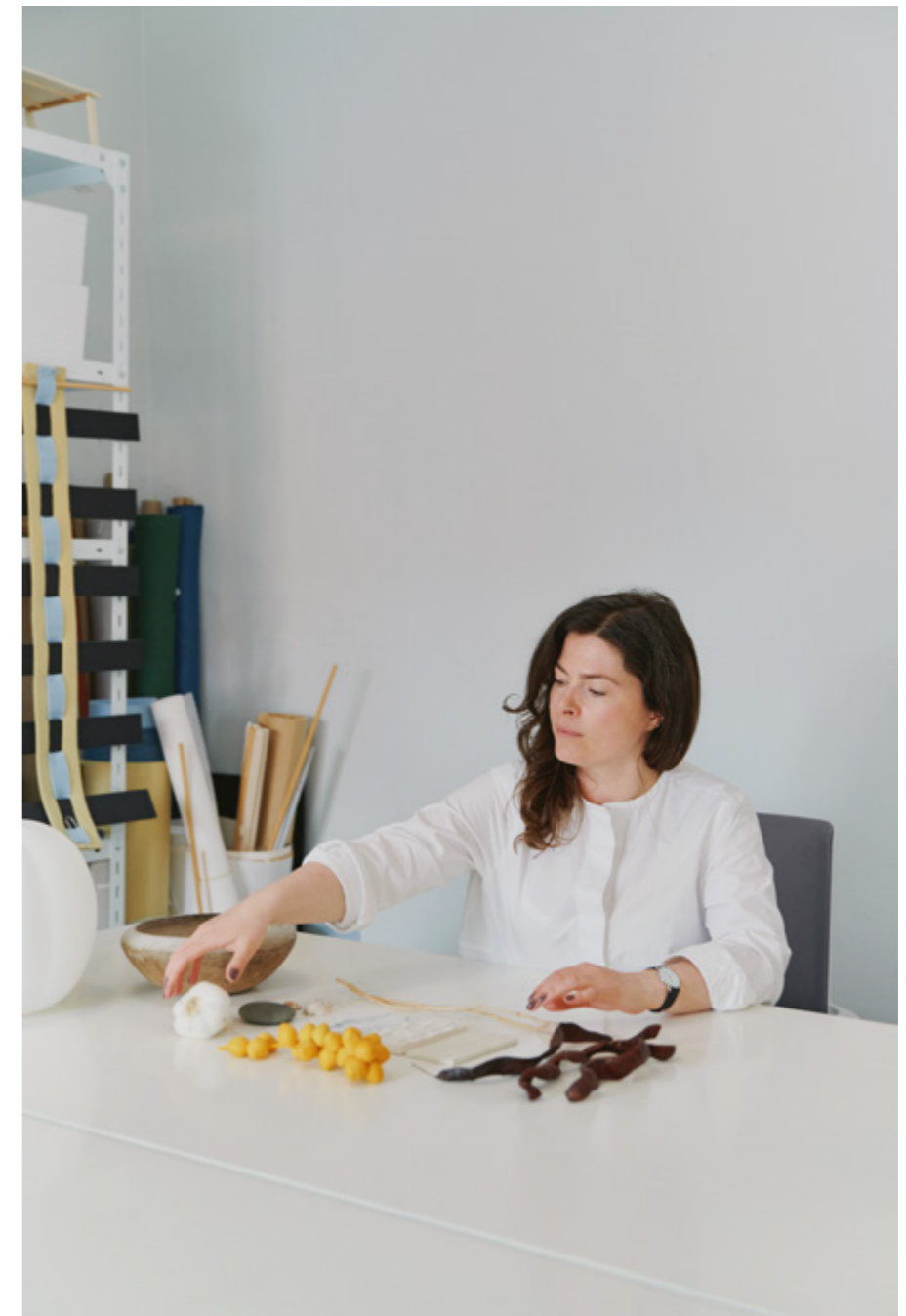
Papier is another design lamp you have created with Made by Hand. What was the inspiration for working with rice paper as a material for a lamp?

Paper is, like glass, a very poetic material if used well. I was very interested in challenging the material and working with

You have been working as designer for many years, but this is your first lamp design? What was your inspiration for PePo glass lamp?

I've been interested in light from very early in my career and it's a field that I worked a lot with during my studies where I created several pieces. PePo was designed with a wish to create a simple yet sculptural lamp with a highly commercial appeal. I really wanted to give the classic glass pendant more character and personality. In my work with PePo I've been





several forms in one and even overlapping shades which is something that I haven't seen in rice paper lamps before. I like the quality of the light that passes through the tactile material and I think it adds so much to an atmosphere.

How are the qualities of rice paper used to distribute light and create ambience in a space?

The properties of rice paper are amazing, the way in which the paper can distribute the light and create mood simply by means of structure and translucency is difficult to imitate.

The distribution of the light through the paper is not only very aesthetic but also highly functional and practical - it's a simple way to add a lot of ambience.

The shapes and forms in the Papier family share some similarities, but also differences. How do they fit together as a family?

Despite the very different choices in material, both designs share a minimalistic feel and belong in a curvy universe with beau-

tiful silhouettes and has a highly versatile use. There is also something interesting in the meeting between these very different materials, that are so different to touch but are equally delicate and poetic.

You introduce coloured rice paper in the Papier family, - what are your thoughts on this design element in the lamp?

Together with Made by Hand, I dreamed of designing a new, light, identity-creating rice paper lamp - a modern take on a classic. One of the new effects I used was colour - colour creates a new dimension and provides an opportunity to create processes, stories and identity in an interior design.

Not that these can be compared, but working with the colored rice paper, I looked at the traditional Asian paper lanterns, which are seen with both sporadic colour and as full coloured.

The Papier lamp is handmade and sold flat-packed and very easy to assemble. Putting a lamp together is where the magic happens, from flat-



packed to a conductor of light. Did you have any concerns working on a flat-packed solutions?

Of course I always have the end user in mind while designing, so it was very im-

portant for me to create a lamp that's easy to assemble and use - it's a part of the experience. Again this is an area where it's great to work with skilled artisans.

Share your best quote...

Oh that's a hard one but I have to say that one of the most important things in the world of design is "That good design takes time" and that is something that Made by Hand understands and that has resulted in some really good collections in great quality.

FLYING LAMP

FLYING is a family of sculptural pendant lamps with a soft organic shape. When suspended, they appear to float beautifully in the air. FLYING lamps are designed, made and distributed with sustainability in mind. The lampshade is created via a 3D knitting process directly from yarn to the final product, so no material is wasted. The LED light source is built into the top of the lamp so the light is softly diffused through the knitted bottom part of the lamp. FLYING lamps are also flat-packed in cardboard, making them compact and therefore more sustainable in terms of transport and distribution.

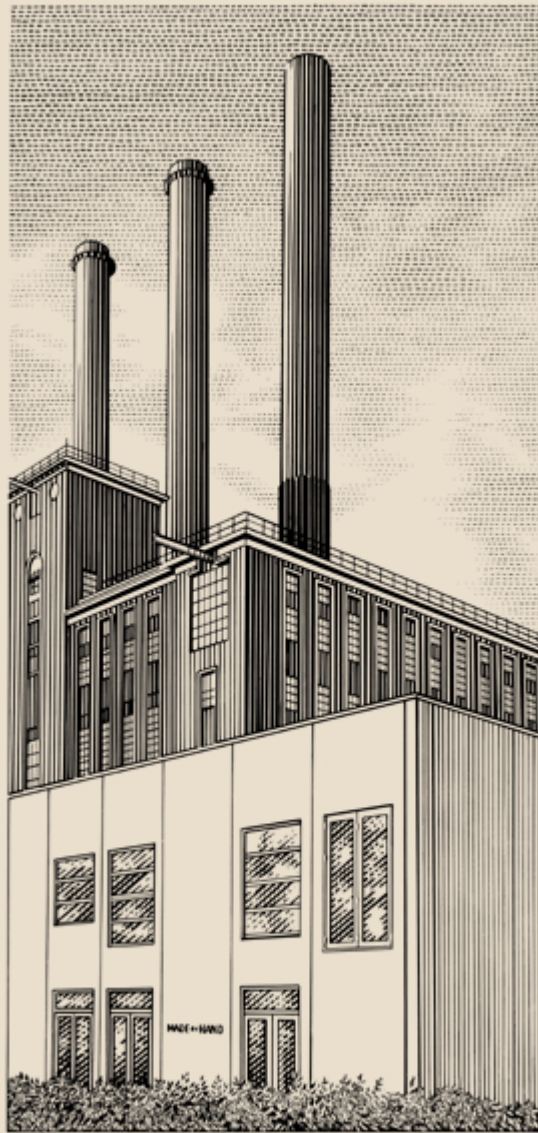
